A) Quota places

Following the conclusion of the World Cup Short Track Speed Skating Competitions, designated for qualification of quota places for the 2018 Olympic Winter Games, held in Budapest (HUN), Dordrecht (NED), Shanghai (CHN) and Seoul (KOR), and in line with Rule 284 and ISU Communication 2044 and 2106, quota places for the XXIII Olympic Winter Games 2018 in PyeongChang have been determined as follows:

These SOQCs also determine stand-by lists of quota places which will be activated if some allocated quota places will not be confirmed by NOCs concerned.

ISU Members/NOCs who do not intend to make full use of their entry quota (i.e. if the respective NOC would not select the number of skaters indicated in the columns "Total Entry Quota") are kindly requested to inform the ISU Secretariat as soon as possible, but not later than January 10, 2018.

B) Stand-by lists of quota places

Unused quota places will be reallocated to ISU Members/NOCs based on the different Special Olympic Qualification Classification lists (SOQCs), as per Rule 284, paragraph 5, subject to the IOC maximum quota of 60 athletes per gender. The reallocation process will be finalized not later than January 22, 2018.
