I. General Regulations

Any events will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Ice Dance 2021, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation at events is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2371, 2393 and

subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR

Rhythm Dance In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2021, Rule 709. Rhythms,

required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 2371,

2393 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Dance In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2021, Rule 710. The required

elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2371, 2393 and

subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Advanced Novice

Pattern Dance 1 - Westminster Waltz

Pattern Dance 2 - Blues

<u>Free Dance</u> Duration: 3:00 min. +/- 10 sec.

Intermediate Novice

Pattern Dances

One of the two groups announced for the season shall be drawn before the first practice of the competition. Each group contains two (2) Pattern Dances.

The following pattern dances to be skated:

→ Group 3: Foxtrot and European Waltz

→ Group 4: Kilian and Starlight Waltz

Free Dance Duration: 2:30 min. +/- 10 sec.

Basic Novice

Pattern Dances

Two of the three Pattern Dances announced for the season shall be published the latest at the draw of the competition.

From three (3) Pattern Dances, two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated from the following:

→ Foxtrot, Dutch Waltz and Rhythm Blues.

Free Dance Duration: 2:00 min. +/- 10 sec.

NON ISU Categories

CUBS - Age requirements - Born after 30th June, 2010

Pattern Dance - Rhythm Blues

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Levels explanation: For Pattern Dances, there will be no key points described and up to Level 1 will be evaluated.

The factor of the Program Components is 0.7



Free Dance Duration: 2:00 min. +/- 10 sec.

Rule 710 shall apply (including that the music may be vocal).

A Well Balanced Free Dance program must contain:

- → One (1) Set of Synchronized Twizzles (FD Variation)
- → Three (3) Choreographic Elements: One (1) of which must be a Choreographic Character Step Sequence and two (2) must be additional chosen from:
 - Choreographic Lift
 - Choreographic Twizzling Movement
 - Choreographic Sliding Movement
 - Choreographic Spinning Movement

Levels explanation: In all Required Elements (except Choreographic Element), **Level 1** is the maximum level the Cubs couple may receive for all required elements. Any additional features the couple chooses to perform will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The factor of the Program Components is 1.0

MINI CUBS – Age requirements - Born after 30th June, 2011

Pattern Dance - Dutch Waltz

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Levels explanation: For Pattern Dances, there will be no key points described and up to Level 1 will be evaluated.

The factor of the Program Components is 0.7

<u>Free Dance</u> Duration: 2:00 min. +/- 10 sec.

Rule 710 shall apply (including that the music may be vocal).

A Well Balanced Free Dance program must contain:

- → One (1) Set of Synchronized Twizzles (FD Variation)
- → Three (3) Choreographic Elements: One (1) of which must be a Choreographic Character Step Sequence and two (2) must be additional chosen from:
 - Choreographic Lift
 - Choreographic Twizzling Movement
 - Choreographic Sliding Movement
 - Choreographic Spinning Movement

Levels explanation: In all Required Elements (except Choreographic Element), **Level 1** is the maximum level the Cubs couple may receive for all required elements. Any additional features the couple chooses to perform will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The factor of the Program Components is 1.0
