## **1. Organizer of the competition:** the Hungarian National Skating Federation (HNSF)

## 2. Location: Practice Rink, Budapest

The competition will be held in the covered Practice Rink with an indoor ice rink measuring 30x60 metres and a movable padding system. The compass of the track is 111.12 metres with curves of 8 metres as per the ISU Rules. There will be seven (7) tracks with a displacement of 0,7 metre each, while the finish line for all distances is the same and only the starting place of distances 500 metres and 1500 metres will be changed.

**3.** Date: October 18-20, 2024

## 4. Guiding rules:

The competition will be carried out according to the International Skating Union's (ISU) General Regulations 2024 and the relevant Communications.

## 5. Participation:

- only registered competitors of ISU Members and affiliated clubs are allowed to participate, entries can be made only through the respective members
- only those competitors who have submitted their entries and paid the entry fee by the given deadline are allowed to participate

<u>Please indicate your intention of participation as soon as possible in order to enable us to prepare the competition as well as possible.</u>

## 6. Technicalities:

- categories, age groups for Challenger Series competition (according to Rule 108)

Entries can only be accepted if a skater is entered into the correct age category according to their date of birth, there is no possibility to enter in a higher category.

\*Junior C and Junior D competitors can be entered into the competition in limited numbers and only from the Visegrad Group countries (V4- Poland, Czechia, Slovakia and Hungary) and they will compete out of the Challenger Series competition distances. After the registration deadline, applicants will be notified at the email address provided in the registration on the shorttraclive.info website about the possibility of participation, depending on the number of entries.

relay entries: each ISU Member and/or their Clubs have the right to enter more than one team per category. The Members / Clubs have to rank their relay teams (the fastest team to be ranked 1). The accepted number of Mixed Relay entries will depend on the schedule of the event. Relay members must have participated in the individual events.

#### 7. Conditions of Contest

- the individual competition is an All-Round competition. All Final System is used as qualification procedure. The make-up of races will be made according to Rule 296 and the Memorandum. Final points (34-21-13-8-5-3-2-1) will be awarded in the respective Finals considering Racing Rule 295 § 5.
- 8. Entries: by submitting an entry the competitors clearly agree to all terms set in this Announcement.
- **Preliminary Entries** must reach the OC by **26th of September 2024** at the latest
- the **Final Entry** must be electronically (<u>www.shorttracklive.info</u>) entered not later than **1**<sup>st of</sup> **October 2024** and should include the following:
  - \* the title of the competition
  - \* the name of the Club and ISU Member making the entry
  - \* the number of athletes in each category
  - \* the number of coaches and team leaders
  - \* the first (given) name and surname of the competitor(s)
  - \* the date of birth of the competitor(s)
  - \* the date and time of arrival and departure of the competitor(s) and those accompanying them
  - \* the financial statement of the respective Club/ISU Member that all occurring costs will be covered by them

- the **entry fee** for the Senior, Junior A and Junior B categories is **50**, **EUR/person** and for the Junior C and Junior D categories is **30**, **EUR/person**
- the entry fee must be paid via bank transfer until <u>14th of October 2024</u>. Please note that **helmet** covers and transponders will only be handed over at the Technical Meeting if payment is fulfilled!

- cancellation is only accepted by the HNSF in case of an injury or illness strictly supported by medical certificate, in which case the amount of entry fee will be refunded.

#### 9. Payment:

- **10. Equipment:** only that equipment which are in accordance with the ISU Rules can be used in the competitions; this will be checked in the Heat Box before the competitors enter the ice.
  - compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades
  - helmet
  - cut proof gloves
  - neck protectors
  - cut-proof skin suit for competition

#### 11. Awards:

The first three placed competitors of each distance in each category receive a medal immediately after the respective final on ice. The first three placed competitors of the individual all-round competition, and the first three placed relay teams in each category will be awarded with medals respectively at the end of the competition.

#### 12. Accommodation:

All meals and lodging expenses are to be paid by the participating members. The OC recommends hotels nearby the Ice Rink, listed below, please make your reservation directly. The rooms are available in limited numbers.
