1. Organizer of the competition: the Hungarian National Skating Federation (HNSF)

2. Location: Practice Rink, Budapest

The competition will be held in the covered Practice Rink with an indoor ice rink measuring 30x60 metres and a movable padding system. The compass of the track is 111.12 metres with curves of 8 metres as per the ISU Rules. There will be seven (7) tracks with a displacement of 0,7 metre each, while the finish line for all distances is the same and only the starting place of distances 500 metres and 1500 metres will be changed.

3. Date: October 16-19, 2025

4. Guiding rules:

The competition will be carried out according to the International Skating Union's (ISU) General Regulations 2024, the relevant Communications and the ISU Short Track Guidance to the racing rules 2025/26.

5. Participation:

- only registered competitors of ISU Members and affiliated clubs and are allowed to participate, entries can be made only through the respective members.
- only those competitors who have submitted their entries and paid the entry fee by the given deadline are allowed to participate
- the organizing committee may close the registrations earlier, in case of too many entries.

<u>Please indicate your intention of participation as soon as possible in order to enable us to prepare the competition as well as possible.</u>

6. Technicalities:

Entries can only be accepted if a skater is entered into the correct age category according to their date of birth, there is no possibility to enter in a higher category.

Should the number of entries in the Junior C category be excessively high and thereby affect the conduct of the competition, the Organizing Committee shall have the right, in order to safeguard the smooth running of the competition, to reduce the number of entries per Member on a proportional basis.

relay entries: each ISU Member and/or their Clubs have the right to enter more than one team per category. The Members / Clubs have to rank their relay teams (the fastest team to be ranked 1). The accepted number of Mixed Relay entries will depend on the schedule of the event. Relay members must have participated in the individual events. In case a Club does not have the sufficient number of skaters to enter a Relay Team, it is permitted to form a combined Relay Team; however, such a Team may only consist of skaters from the same Member.

7. Conditions of Contest

- the seeding for the first distance shall be determined according to the skaters' officially registered personal best times.

- the individual competition in the Olympic Hopes Challenger Series competition is an All-Round competition. Knock-out system with repechage is used as qualification procedure. The make-up of races will be made according to Rule 296 and the Memorandum. Final points (34-21-13-8-5-3-2-1) will be awarded in the respective Finals considering Racing Rule 297 §.
- **8. Entries:** by submitting an entry the competitors clearly agree to all terms set in this Announcement.
- Preliminary Entries must reach the OC by 25th of September 2025 at the latest
- the **Final Entry** must be electronically (<u>www.shorttracklive.info</u>) entered not later than **2**nd **of October 2025** and should include the following:
 - * the title of the competition
 - * the name of the Club and ISU Member making the entry
 - * the number of athletes in each category
 - * the number of coaches and team leaders
 - * the first (given) name and surname of the competitor(s)
 - * the date of birth of the competitor(s)
 - * the date and time of arrival and departure of the competitor(s) and those accompanying them
 - * the financial statement of the respective Club/ISU Member that all occurring costs will be covered by them

Skaters whose personal best time(s) are not available on the <u>www.shorttracklive.info</u> website, shall be required to submit their official personal best times(s) by e-mail to <u>comp.steward@hunskate.hu</u> no later than the entry deadline (02.10.2025).

- the **entry fee** for the Senior, Junior A and Junior B categories is **60**, **EUR/person** and for the Junior C category it is **40**, **EUR/person**
- the entry fee must be paid via bank transfer until <u>8th of October 2025</u>. Please note that **helmet** covers and transponders will only be handed over at the Technical Meeting if payment is fulfilled!

- cancellation is only accepted by the HNSF in case of an injury or illness strictly supported by medical certificate, in which case the amount of entry fee will be refunded.

9. Payment:

Accepted payment methods: bank transfer (only in advance)

10. Equipment: only that equipment which are in accordance with the ISU Rules can be used in the competitions; this will be checked in the Heat Box before the competitors enter the ice.

- compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades
- helmet
- cut proof gloves
- neck protectors
- cut-proof skin suit for competition
- eye wear protection

11. Awards:

The first three placed competitors of each distance in each category receive a medal immediately after the respective final on ice. The first three placed competitors of the individual Challenger Series competition, and the first three placed relay teams in Challenger Series category will be awarded with medals respectively at the end of the competition.

The Senior and Junior A categories will skate together; however, the overall results will be classified separately for each category.

12. Accommodation:

All meals and lodging expenses are to be paid by the participating members. The OC recommends hotels nearby the Ice Rink, listed below, please make your reservation directly. The rooms are available in limited numbers.

- by entering all participants accept and agree that they might be subject to recording (audio and picture), and might appear in the media content created about the competition
- by entering all participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, sex
- the OC provides medical service (ambulance) during the competition
