I. Általános szabályok

A versenyszabályzat a 2024. évi ISU Általános és Technikai Szabályzata, továbbá az érvényben lévő ISU Kommunikációk figyelembevételével került összeállításra.

II. Korhatárok

Az ISU 2024. évi Általános Szabályzatának 108 paragrafusának 3. és 4. pontja alapjai alapján, továbbá a 2025/26. évi szezonban érvényben lévő ISU Kommunikációk és azok frissítése alapján.

III. MOKSZ versenyzőkre vonatkozó előírások

Csak és kizárólag az a versenyző részvétele engedélyezett, aki MOKSZ tagsággal rendelkező sportszervezet leigazolt sportolója, érvényes versenyengedéllyel és sportorvosi igazolással bír.

Kategóriák szabályozása – nemzetközi standard alapján

ISU SENIOR:

At least age of 17 before July 1, 2025

The Team shall consist of 16 skaters with maximum of 4 alternates.

Short Program: maximum 2 minutes 50 seconds, Factor 1,33

Free Skating Program: 4 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Senior Short Program and Senior Free Skating,

If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during Competition, the Team will be permitted to skate with not less than 14 Skaters.

ISU JUNIOR:

At least age of 13 but have not reached the age of 19 before July 1, 2025

a Team shall consist of twelve to sixteen Skaters - according the rule 800 in the 2024 Special Regulations and Technical Rules

Short Program: maximum 2 minutes 50 seconds, Factor 1,33

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Junior Short Program and Junior Free Skating.

BASIC NOVICE:

The skaters must have reached the age of 10 but have not reached the age of 16 by July 1, 2025.

The Team shall consist of 12 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67,

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Basic novice free program

The highest difficulty Group of an Additional Feature may be attempted and will be called as executed.

At Synchronized Spin level 1 is the max call, according to the Well Balanced Program Content 2025-2026.

JUVENILE:

The skaters must have not reached the age of 13 by July 1, 2025.

The Team shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Basic Novice free program

The highest level of elements can be skated, but only a maximum of level 3 will be called. Maximum of SySp Level 1 will be called.

PRE-JUVENILE:

The skaters must have not reached the age of 11 by July 1, 2025.

The Team shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2635 Basic Novice

The highest level of elements can be skated, but only a maximum of level 2 will be called. Maximum of SySp Level 1 will be called.

MINI:

The skaters must have not reached the age of 9 by July 1, 2025.

The Team shall consist of 6 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

75% of the team did not compete in the previous season in any other SYS category.

Ice coverage requirement is maximum 50% of the rink. Ice coverage requirement of the required elements is also proportionally smaller.

Free Skating Program: 2 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67

5 elements are obligatory: block, line, circle, wheel and intersection or move element.

Max call: maximum element levels 2.

MIXED AGE:

The Team shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters, there are no age limits.

Free Skating Program: 3,30 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 2,67,

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2692 Mixed Age

Max call: maximum element levels 3. The highest difficulty Group of an Additional Feature may be attempted and will be called as executed.

Follows the General rules for the Junior category. Illegal Elements are following the restriction of Rule 992 para 2. c) Deductions will be in accordance with Rule 843 para 1. m)

ADULT

The skaters must have reached the age of 18 by July 1 the year preceding the competition, a minimum of 50 % of the skaters must be over 23.

The Team Shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 seconds), Factor 1,67

Well Balanced Program Content and other rules will be according to the ISU Technical Requirements for International Adult Figure Skating Competitions 2025-26 for adult teams.

Max call: maximum element levels and the highest difficulty Group of an Additional Feature may be attempted and will be called as executed.

Age rules for Interclub categories:

75% of the skaters performing the program have to be in the correct age of the category, 25% can be out of the age limit. For the other 25% a permissible age deviation of +/-2 years is permitted for Mini, Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile and Non ISU Basic Novice, a permissible age deviation of -3 years is permitted for Adult. This exception applies to the competition team. In a team of 20, a maximum of 4 skaters can be younger or older. In the spirit of fair play, please note: If you have a team of e.g. 16 skaters and you skate your free skating e.g. with 12 skaters, you can only have 3 skaters that don't meet the age criteria (younger or older) on the competing team

50% of the skaters can be overlapped if you have more teams competing.
